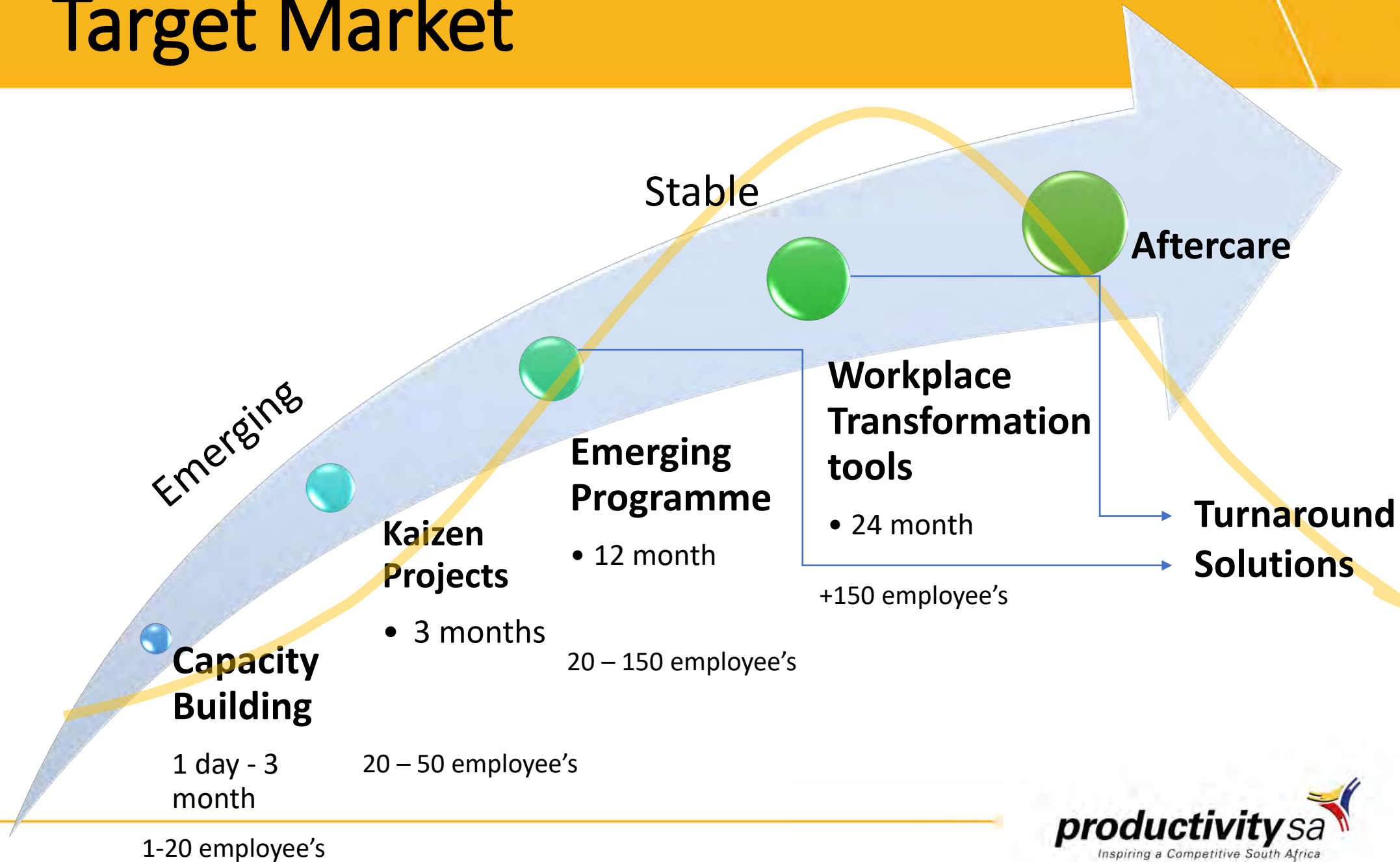

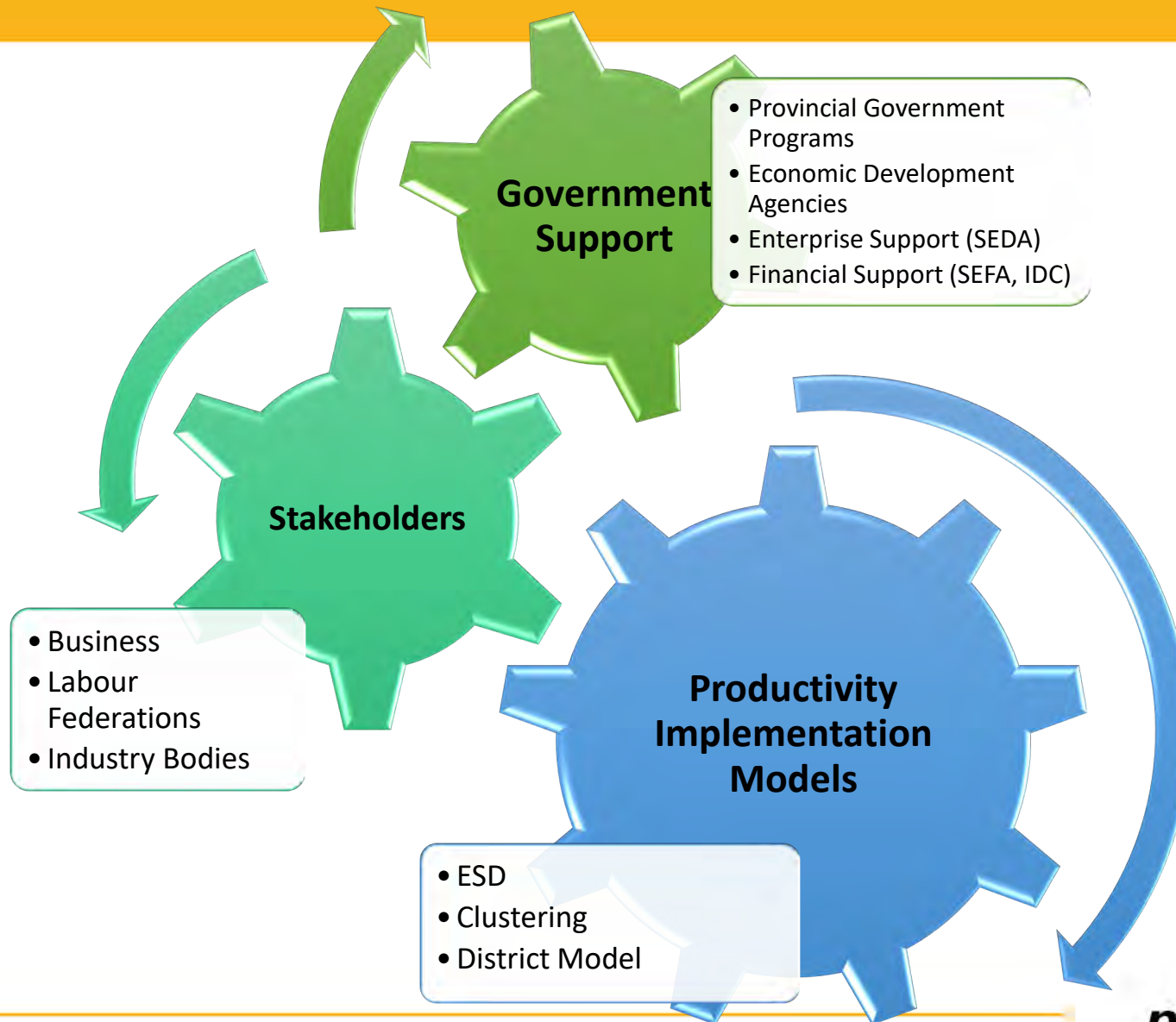
MISSION

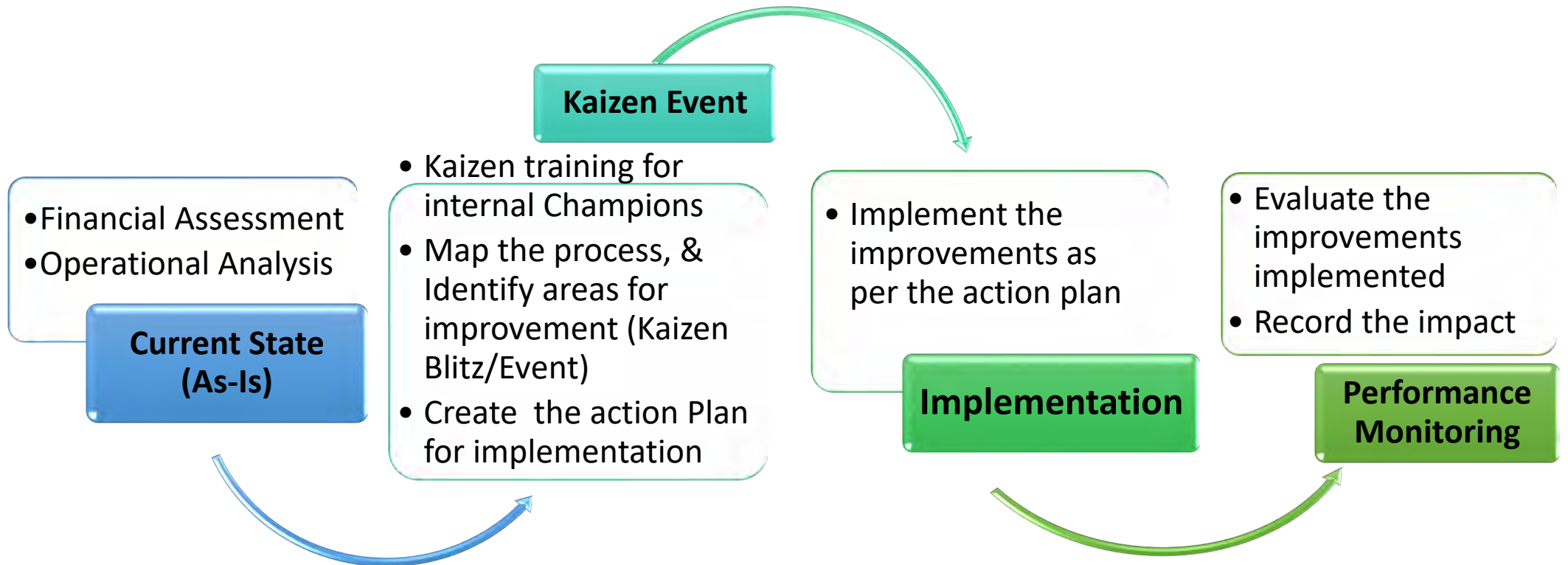
Integrative Approach Target Market

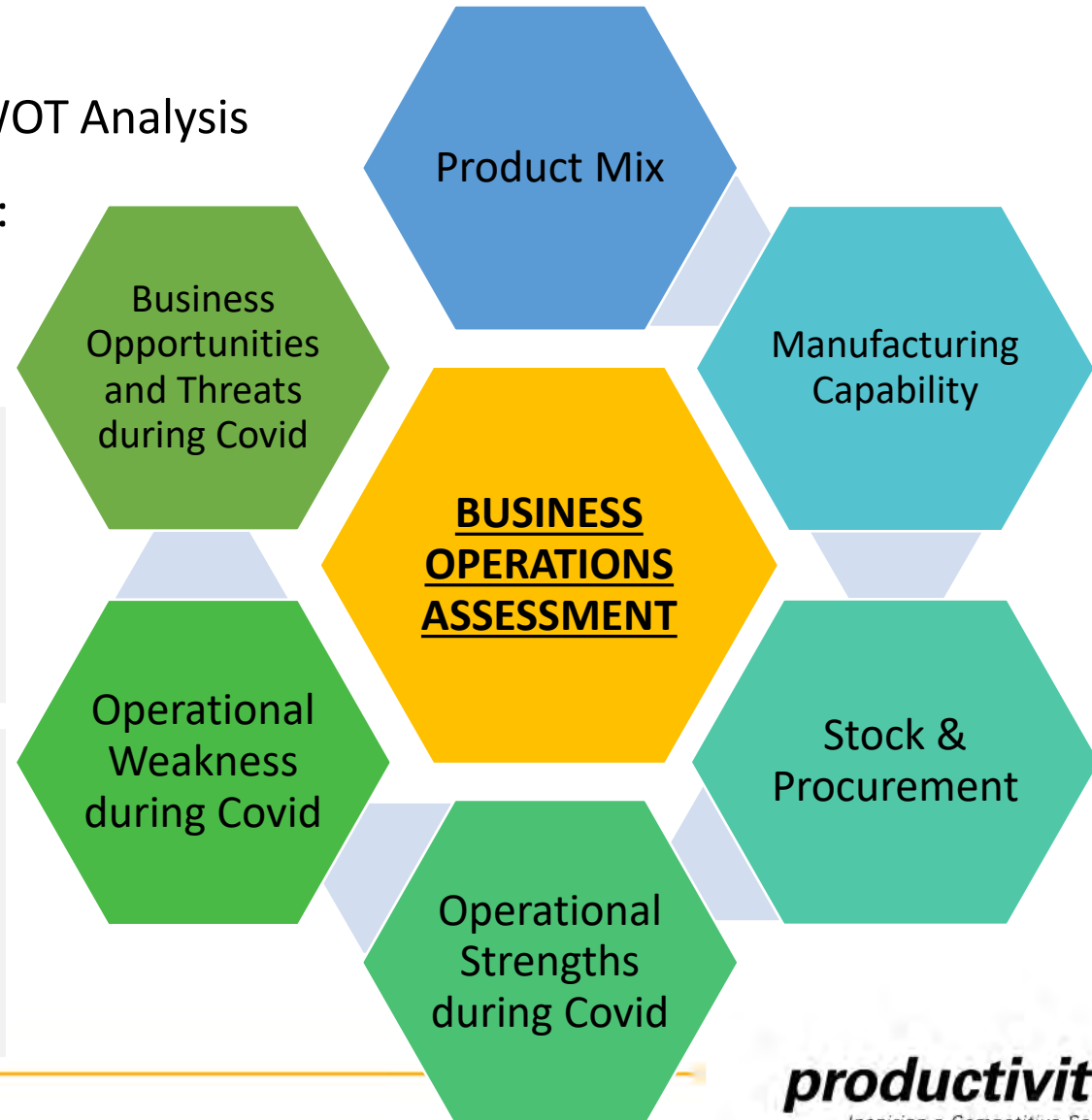

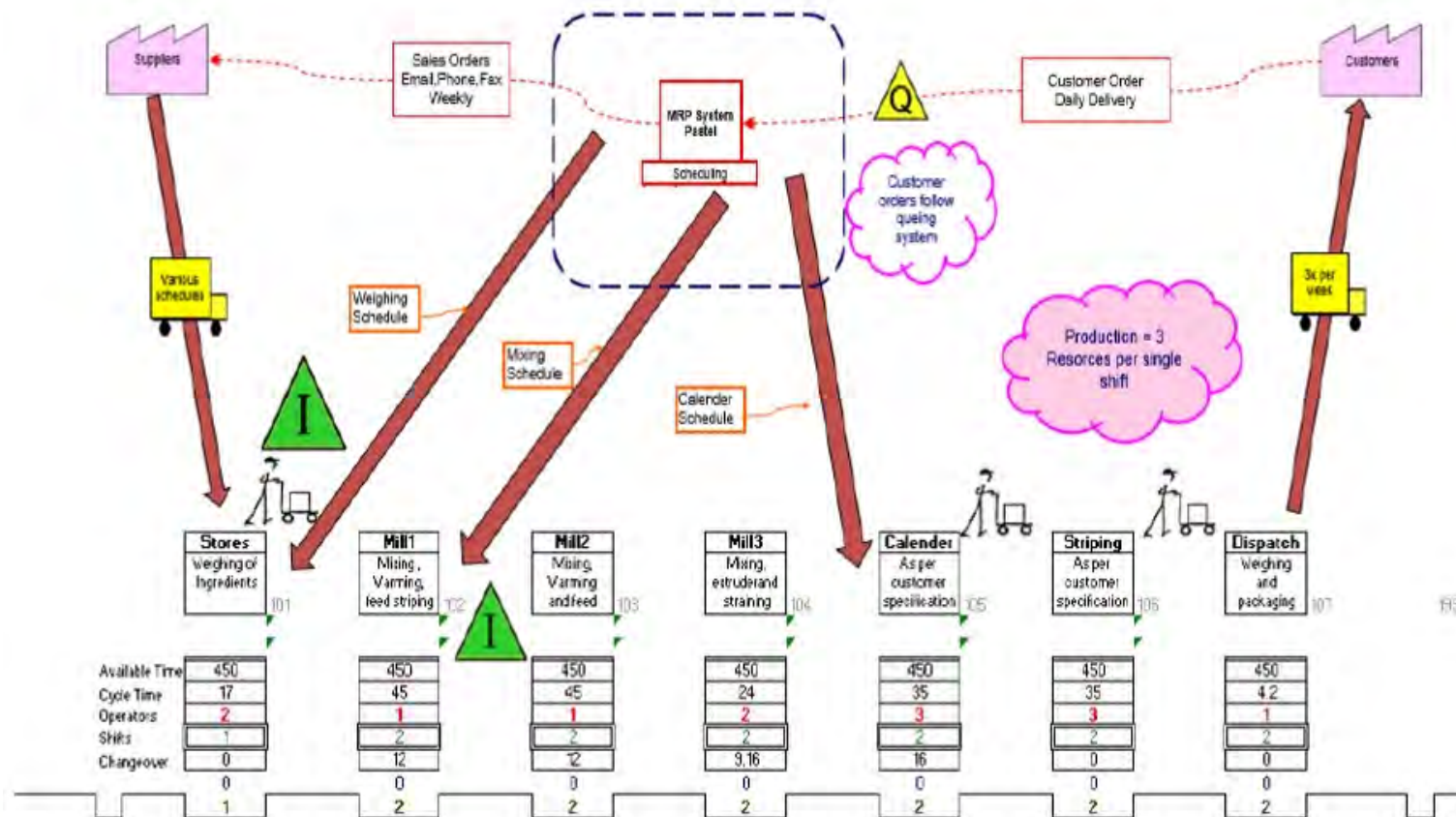

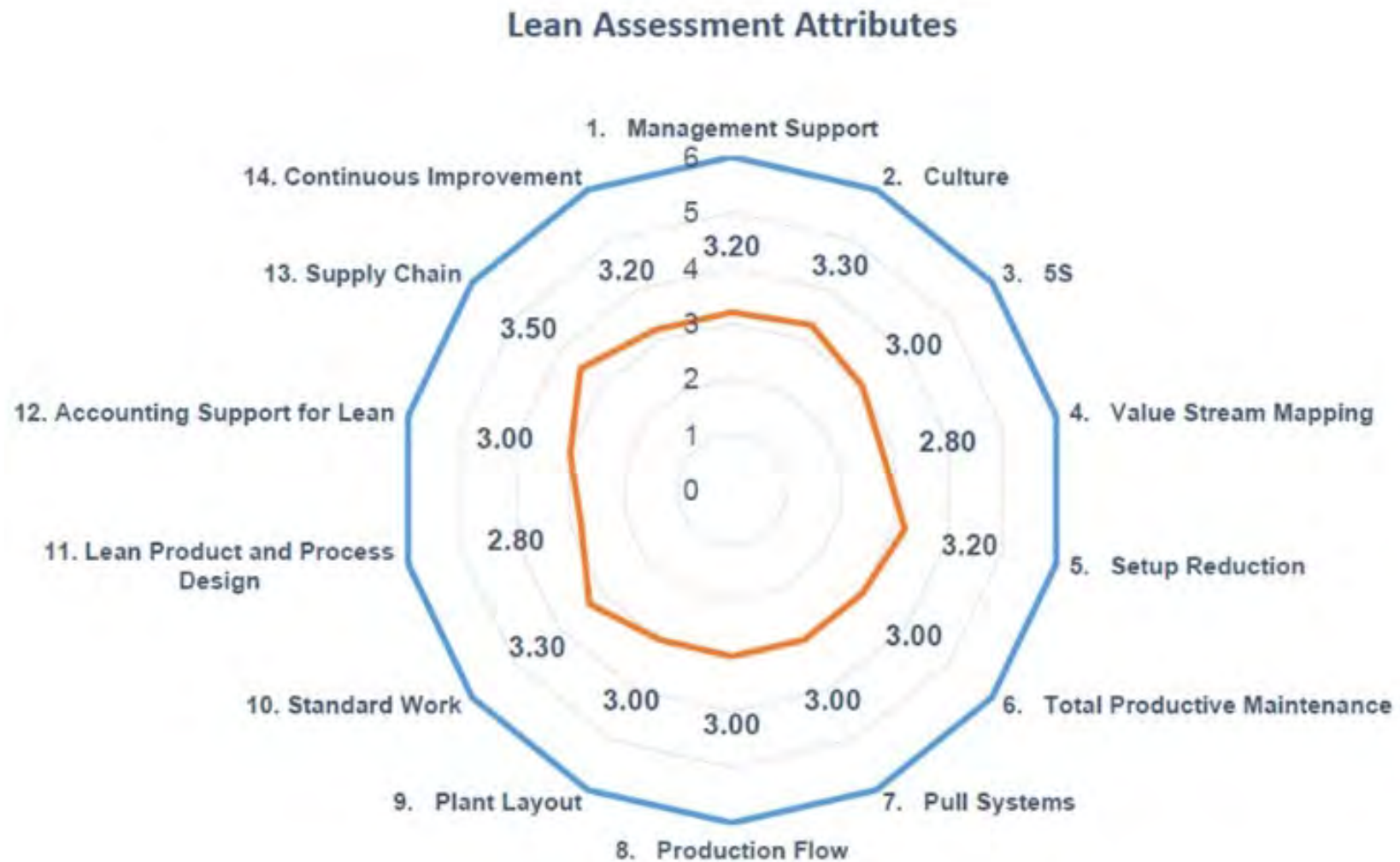
Operational Efficiency Approaches
